Moved by Watters supported by Gerace to amend agenda by deleting Item E under Clerk. No discussion. Vote taken. All yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Gerace supported by Bock to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2025, Board meeting without corrections. No discussion. Vote taken. All yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Gerace supported by Duplanty for hiring of Chelsa Murphy as a Firefighter at Station #1 pending passing of pre-employment qualifications. No discussion. Roll call vote taken. All yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Gerace supported by Watters to approve Waldorf & Sons Inc. sanitary sewer and water emergency repair invoices in the amount of \$40,927.29. Discussion held. Eashoo stated that these invoices are for force main repairs and keeping the pumps running during power outages. Watters asked if this was coming out of the sewer and water account. Eashoo stated yes. Roll call vote taken. All yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Duplanty supported by Watters to approve GHA Technologies invoice in the amount of \$2,950. Discussion held. Eashoo stated that this is our IT licensing agreement for one year. Roll call vote taken. All yes. Motion carried.

Update regarding the Master Plan and Survey. Eashoo stated that surveys are available for all residents to fill out and return to the Township. Wade Trim has a rough draft ready if anyone would like to review it. Community involvement meetings will be held on Wednesday, September 17, 2025, from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. and Wednesday, October 15, 2025, from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. Public input is welcome.

The cost is \$45,000.
